Introduction

The Herb Clinic has partnered with Onaya Science, The Ayahuasca Foundation and Heroic Hearts to offer a study to investigate the effects of ayahuasca retreats on military Veterans with posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and/or traumatic brain injury (TBI). The first study was conducted at the Riosbo Research Center, situated in the heart of the Allpahuaya-Mishana National Reserve, near Iquitos, Peru. Research kicked off in March of 2023, this experiment will be Onaya Science's most advanced study to date, incorporating neuroimaging (fMRI and EEG), microbiome, metabolomics, and epigenetic analyses, and more. The Herb Clinic participated in a pilot program study in May 2023 to add an additional center for which research will be conducted. We are excited to announce we will be taking groups of 9 Veterans and 1 Facilitator down in September 2023, February 2024, and September 2024 for privately organized retreats. For these retreats, we are looking for sponsorship to decrease the barriers for our participants and provide an unrivaled experience in their healing. We are currently looking to raise \$70,000CAD per retreat. Following the 3 planned retreats we are planning to continue to bring down two groups per year for the next 5 years.

Who they are

TThe Herb Clinic was founded in 2017 to provide education to Physicians and their patients about the medical use of Cannabis. They have helped 10,000+ patients gain access to this plant medicine and continue to provide their services to anyone in need. With a huge focus on education, The Herb Clinic continues to expand its knowledge of different Plant Medicine Therapies around the world. They have applied for their "Dealer's License" through Health Canada to permit them access to import/export these substances and gain insight into their effectiveness for conditions commonly found within their patient demographic. The Herb Clinic also operates Medical Clinic at Southpointe, a medical clinic striving to change the way healthcare is viewed and delivered. They are working to build an integrated, preventative healthcare model for Veterans, First Responders, their families, and their community. By working together with established research teams and nonprofit organizations, they hope to expand their knowledge of different treatment modalities around the world and eventually bring that knowledge back to Canada to provide access to more people in need.

Onaya Science

Who they are

Onaya Science is a non-profit research team, they design and conduct experiments in Peru, specifically focused around Ayahuasca and other plant remedies found in the Amazon. They are dedicated to delivering scientific data on a non-profit basis working alongside the local indigenous communities. They are a team of researchers striving to translate the indigenous knowledge of Amazonian plant medicines into scientific terminology and data, whilst ensuring the traditions are respected. They use cutting edge scientific methods to provide greater layers of understanding to the ancient wisdom of the Amazon. Onaya Science investigates the overlaps and differences between two paradigms which appear on the surface to seem contrary. Driven by the goal of shedding light on healing modalities that have been ignored by modern medicine yet have served the people of the Amazon since before records began

Research Publications

1. Ceremonial ayahuasca in Amazonian Retreats-mental health and epigenetic outcomes from a six-month naturalistic study.

Funded by the Medical Research Council (UK), this study looks at the effects of ayahuasca retreats on the reprocessing of traumatic memories, mental health outcomes, as well as providing preliminary data into potential epigenetic changes in DNA. This study was featured in Forbes.

2. Modulatory Effects of Ayahuasca on Personality Structure in a Traditional Framework. Independently funded by the research team, this study provided foundational data which displayed that ayahuasca ceremonies had the power to alter personality, by reducing levels of Neuroticism (by 20%) on a standardized model of personality, the NEO-PI3; also known as the 'Big Five'. 3. The Pharmacological Interaction of Compounds Present in Ayahuasca- a systematic review.

The systematic review searched literary databases for publication into the pharmacology of ayahuasca, with the objective into the pharmacology of ayahuasca, with the objective of establishing a comprehensive understanding of the chemistry of the brew, and how it interacts in the body. The review found data which suggests that the brews may result from synergistic properties, as well as additives. It concludes that surface level understanding exists, and that further research is required.
